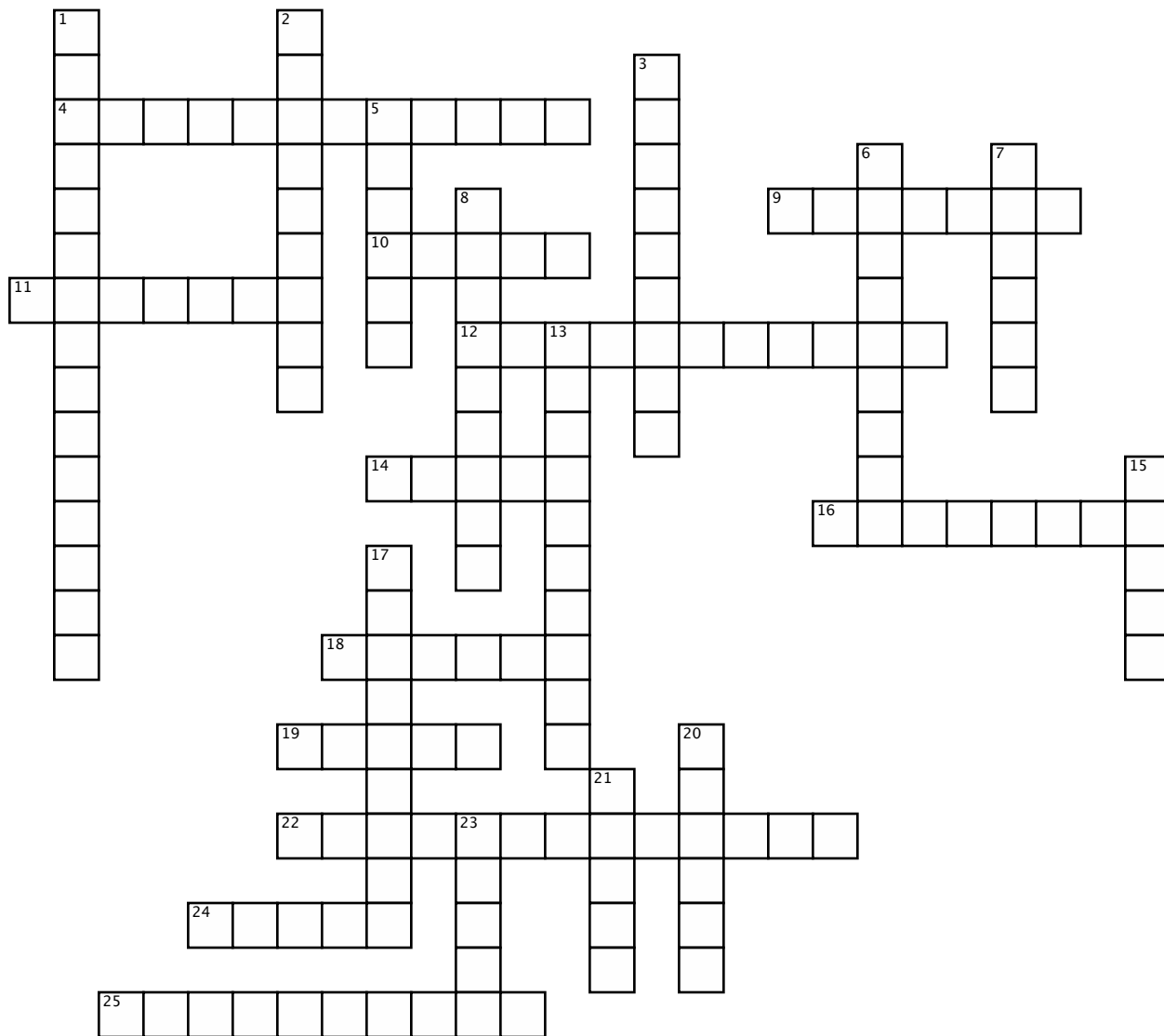


Lakes and Reservoirs

5. Between Lake Pontchartrain and the Gulf of Mexico
6. The lake to the south of Jena

8. The major lake that is almost between Lake Charles and the Gulf of Mexico
13. This reservoir partially separates Louisiana and Texas
15. Tensas Parish Airport is located on a peninsula on this oxbow lake near the Mississippi River
